Irish Limousin Breed History

The First 10 years (1972-1982)

The first seven Limousin heifers were imported into Ireland by Paddy Clancy of the renowned Clancy Brothers and Tommy Makem folk-music group in 1971.

The first Limousin calf born in Ireland was Cregg Harmonie. She was born on June 22nd, 1972. The first 12 calves from the Cregg herd were all exported to a very lucrative Canadian market.

The next major importation of Limousin cattle was in 1973 and consisted of 94 heifers and 5 bulls. These heifers cost between £1,500 -£2,250. By comparison in 1973, 1L of petrol cost just €0.08.

The Irish Limousin Cattle Society's (ILCS) first meeting was held on February 16th, 1973 in Silver Springs Hotel in Cork.

The first AGM of the Irish Limousin Cattle Society was held in Cashel Palace Hotel, Cashel, Co. Tipperary

The First Council

Redmond Gallagher, Roger Mc Carrick, Nicholas Grubb, Eric Williams, Richard Whelan, James Nagle, Arthur Ponsoby, Paddy Clancy, Dick Collins, Seamus Cody, Niall Cullen, Iriel Thornton.

At this stage, the ILCS was an All- Ireland organisation which saw cattle from both north and south of the border registered in the Irish herdbook.

The first Limousin sale was held at the Midland and Western Showgrounds in Carrick-on-Shannon in conjunction with the April bull sales on April 19th and 20th 1977. The top priced animal was Ballysorrel Leo – exhibited by Seamus Cody and purchased by Dovea AI for £1,800.

The Second 10 years (1982-1992)

The second 10 years started off as troubled financial ones for the ILCS, with northern breeders registering calves instead with the British Limousin Cattle Society. Revenue was halved from the previous year.

Consequently, the calf registration fee was increased to £35 – a fee it remains at 40 years later.

Nicholas and Barbara Grubb took over role of breed secretary in 1982 and the offices were moved to their home in Castlegrace. The Grubb family continued as breed secretary and the offices remained in an annex to their family home for the next 24 years.

1983 – The Limousin Roadshow

The brainchild of Nicholas Grubb and Seamus and Mary Cody saw a Limousin bull - Castle Shane – travel to 15 marts across the country to promote the attributes of the breed. Raffle tickets to win the bull were sold at each mart. Such was the success that it was repeated in 1984 and 1985.

The first official Limousin sale was held in Cahir Mart on April 5th, 1983 with an average of £1,450 for 25 bulls and 23 heifers.

1985 and Naas Mart saw the first sale with George Candler as auctioneer. George Candler, 37 years later, remains as the official Limousin breed auctioneer.

National Ploughing Championship, Oak Park, Co. Carlow, 1989, was the venue for the Limousin National Championship. It was decided to coincide the National Championship judging with the ploughing event because of the opportunity to showcase the breed to a huge potential market of buyers.

What was unique was that for years, the cattle were accommodated in a large polytunnel.

60 pedigree Irish-bred cattle competed for the coveted titles. The first ever winner was Pelletstown Buccaneer, bred by the late Dr. Roger McCarrick.

Regional Clubs

The present day North Eastern Club is the oldest club area. It's first meeting was held in January 1988 under the chairman Ray Carolan.

Cork Club was next established in April 1989.

South West, South East and North West were all formed in 1991 and the Clare club was founded in 1999; the Donegal club was founded in 2007.

The role of the clubs was to develop the breed in their respective areas.

The Third 10 years (1992-2002)

The late Seamus Cody was one of the greatest judges of a Limousin animal. Seamus Cody had witnessed the success of linear scoring in France as a breed improvement tool and the ILCS undertook to have him trained as a scorer in France. He was joined by Martin Mc Cullagh as a scorer in 1994. Animals were scored 1-10 on muscle traits, skeletal traits, functionality traits and docility.

This was the first information available in any breed of which bulls were improving or similarly disapproving individual traits.

The indexes were later incorporated into a BLUP – Best Linear Unbiased Breeding Prediction – a forerunner to the present day Eurostars.

Sersia / French Limousin Semen

1992 saw the arrival of the first calves by leading French AI sires. The first bulls selected for usage on Irish pedigree Limousin cows were Tarvis, Ulysse and Villy.

These 3 AI sires were chosen by Seamus Cody and Martin Mc Cullagh having inspected progeny in France. These bulls give the smaller breeder the opportunity and access to use the top genetics available within the breed at a relative modest cost.

Over the years as a result breeders got the opportunity to buy semen from bulls like Dauphin, Highlander, Geant, Epton, Ferry, Espoir, Mas du Clo, Cameos, On-Dit, Bavardage to name but a few.

30 years later and the Irish Limousin Cattle Society association with importation and advice on French AI bulls continue strongly

International Limousin Conference 1994- Ireland

1994 was a busy year for the ILCS in hosting the International Limousin Conference. The organising committee was led by Society President Ray Carolan and Barbara Grubb. Delegates travelled from 16 countries to view Irish Limousin cattle.

The conference centred around the RDS Livestock Show on 9th June in the RDS Ballsbridge. The French born Golfeur owned by Seamus Gallagher was crowned overall champion.

Herd visits to Barnhill (Seamus Gallagher), Pelletstown (Roger Mc Carrick), Luttrestown, Ballysorrell (Cody family), Riverview (Ernest Buttimer) along with visits to scenic and tourist attractions were afforded to delegates.

The Fourth 10 years (2002-2012)

In 2003, Nicholas Grubb retired from ILCS to do contract work with ICBF. A year later in 2004, Barbara Grubb retired as Breed Secretary.

During their tenure working with the ILCS and as a result of strong breed promotion registrations grew from 210 pedigree registered calves in 1982 to 7100 calves registered in 2004. Membership had grown from 35 breeders in 1982 to almost 2000 breeders in 2004.

The Limousin breed had spread to every parish and every townland across Ireland.

Dr. Noel Gowen joined the ILCS as breed development officer in 2003 and later to become Breed Secretary in 2008.

Dr. Ger Ryan joined the ILCS as breed Secretary in 2004 after the departure of Barbara Grubb. He was to remain with the ILCS for 4 years.

Paul Sykes joined the ILCS as Breed Development Officer in 2008 and later became Breed Secretary until his retirement in 2020.

Marie Mahony joined the ILCS administration team in 1999 and has given 23 years unbroken service to the breed. Colette English joined the ILCS team in 2000 and has only recently resigned.

Purchase of ILCS offices

2005 saw the ILCS purchase their present day offices in Kilglass near Mitchelstown. The offices were officially opened in July 2006.

During this decade, record prices were broken and noteworthy prices were achieved. Greenhills Trojan bred by John Greene Donegal, a son of French AI bull Ferry sold for €23,000.

Several other bulls sold from €15,000 to €20,000.

There was a huge demand for the top Irish Limousin genetics from UK breeders rebuilding their herds post Foot and Mouth disease in 2001.

The present day record Limousin animal sold at auction is Milbrook Senhorita. She was sold in October 2003 by the Smith family in Oldcastle, Co. Meath. She was a daughter of French AI bull – Mas du Clo. She realized a whopping €42,000.

This was followed by Ardlea Tammy – a Lino daughter selling for €40,000 euro in 2006.

Records

Hall of Fame Award

The Hall of Fame awards are a national set of recognition awards presented by livestock societies to members who have contributed for many years to the success of their breed.

The awards are presented at a dinner held in Athlone annually. In 2019, the Limousin Society presented our award to Paddy Ryan at the premier sale in Roscrea and did not attend the national awards in Athlone. Due to Covid-19, there were no awards in 2020 or 2021.

All Ireland Derby

The All Ireland Derby was a whole island competition which ran from 2007 to 2013. Originally, there was a class for pedigree bulls and a female class with the Irish Limousin Cattle Society and Northern Ireland Limousin club sending qualifiers to compete. The overall title was decided based on a points system incorporating the results of the two sections. Later, the competition was extended to cover cattle under 20 month divided into four classes.

The first Derby was held at Castlewells Show in 2007 and – under Scottish judge Archie McGregor – William Smith's Milbrook Monique was judged the inaugural Female Champion. We moved to Virginia Show in 2008 and Matt Ridley judged William Smith's Milbrook Baby as the Female Champion. Milbrook Celine completed a very impressive three in a row of female titles in 2009 under judge Peter Henshall for William Smith and his Milbrook herd. The 2009 competition was held in Clogher Valley Show in Co. Tyrone.

2010 saw Ardlea Electra win the female section for Dan Tynan from Co. Laois. The show hosting was Cappamore Co. Limerick with Ron Cruikshank judging. In 2011, we

returned to the lovely surroundings of Castlewells Show, but for the first time the two titles were won by Northern Irish breeders.

2012 brought the Derby to Elphin Show in Co. Roscommon, where William Smith was back in the winner's enclosure with the renowned, Milbrook Gingerspice. This outstanding show heifer was a narrow winner on the day with another icon of the breed, Trueman Grazia in the reserve position. Vicky Smith was the judge in Elphin and when the points were added, the Irish Limousin Cattle Society managed to win the overall Derby Shield for the first time. Enthusiasts in attendance in Elphin were treated to an amazing show of Limousin cattle. However, they could not imagine the impact the two top heifers on the day would have on the breed. Trueman Grazia is the sire of Trueman Jagger – sold in Carlisle in 2015 for a then world record price of £140,000gns. This record was surpassed in 2021 by a Gingerspice daughter – Wilodge Poshspice, who sold for £250,000gns also in Carlisle.

The final Derby was held in 2013 in Castlewells show with Dougie McBeath

judging. Ardnacrusha Hilarious from Donal Moloney was judged Female Champion and after a really close competition, the shield was shared with the Irish Limousin Cattle Society and Northern Ireland Club on equal points.

The derby was an excellent idea and fostered relations between the two areas. While the Northern Ireland Club won the majority of the years, the competition was extremely tight on many occasions.

International Limousin Congress 2016

The international Limousin Congress in 2016 was without doubt a highlight for Limousin breeders and the society. The event took place from August 20th to August 28th and resulted in over 400 international delegates travelling to Ireland to renew friendships with Limousin breeders from all parts of the world and enjoy Irish hospitality. The delegates could have opted for a 3-day, 6-day or 9-day tour and were brought to some iconic Irish destinations and some of the best Irish Limousin herds. Add in a national show and sale, a banquet and some time for shopping – all giving a very busy stay in Ireland. The delegates were based in Athlone and Kilkenny and visits included Bru na Boinne, Clonmacnoise, Newbridge Silverware Visitor Centre, Bunratty Castle, Coolmore Stud, and the Guinness Storehouse. They visited three pedigree herds, John McInerney's Drummin Herd, Dan Tynan's Ardlea Herd and Doreen Corridan's Roundhill Herd and also the McGee Commercial Herd outside Athlone. The North West Limousin Club hosted the group at their club calf finals in Glenamaddy and the national show and sale in Kilkenny on the Friday rounded out the cattle viewing. The weekend was brought to a close with a Gala Banquet held in the Hub Kilkenny – which was a fitting climax to a wonderful week.

Anglo Irish YMA Finals

The Anglo Irish YMA Finals is an annual competition between YMA teams from Ireland, Northern Ireland, England, Scotland and Wales. Competitors are aged between 12 and 25, with teams of four competing. The three sections are judging cattle, giving reasons to the master judge and showing cattle in a ring. The Irish team is selected at a national YMA final where the best young stock handlers represent their clubs in team and individual competition. We have listed the successful club teams in the national finals and also the national team members and where they finished at the international competition. This is a wonderful competition that allows our young members develop their skills, make new friendships and travel. Huge thanks must go to the society officials, parents, coaches, judges and club officials for their efforts over the years in making sure that the Irish Limousin Cattle Society was represented and successful in the competition. Of course, no team could be picked or coached without the competitors and everyone who has competed at club, national and international level are to be commended for their commitment to showing cattle and to the Limousin breed.

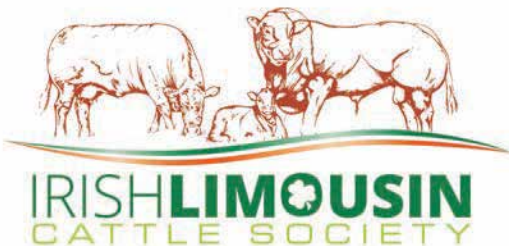

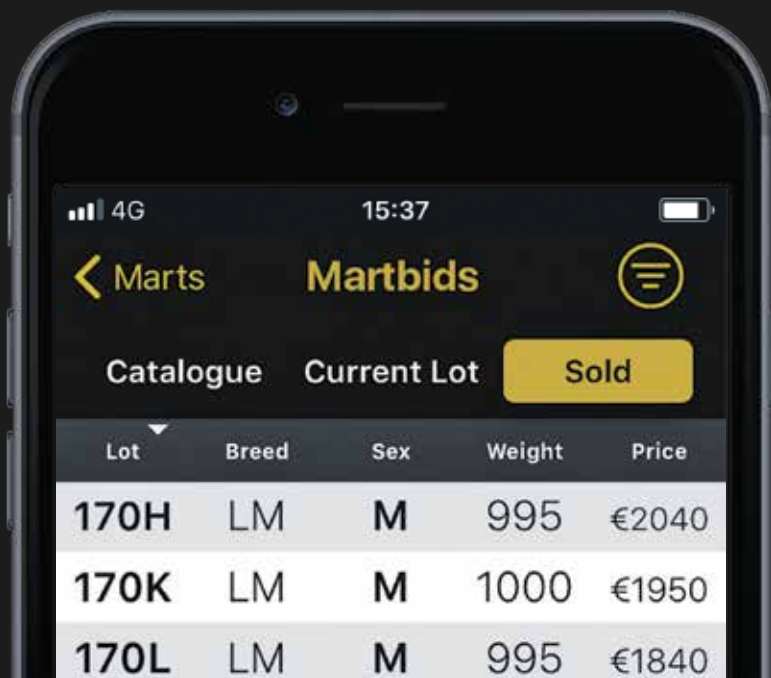

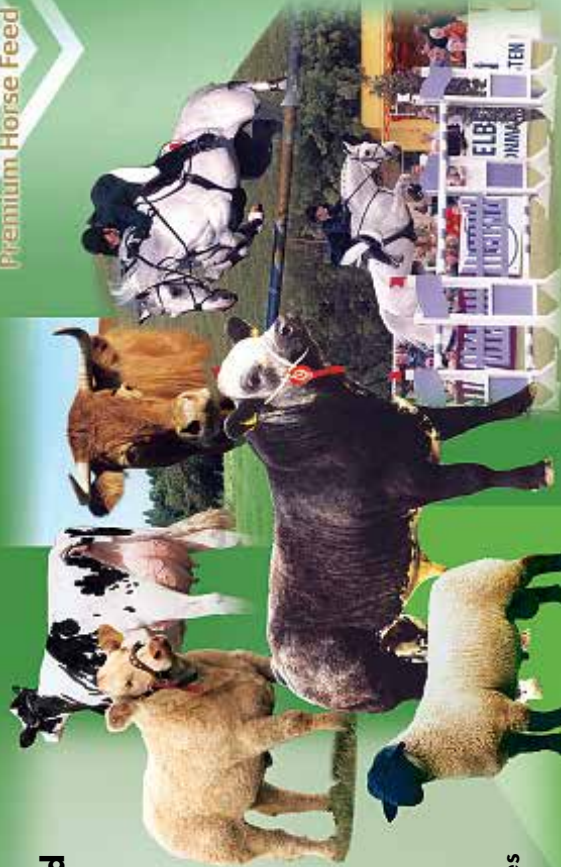

A minimum sale price of €1,800 applies to the heifer sale.

All animals must be trained to a halter and bulls must have a ring in their nose. Adequate halter must be left with the sold animal. Any cattle sold outside the ring must be put through the books. This rule will be strictly enforced.

Vendors must also present to the steward their Blue Card and Pedigree Certificate. Animals without these documents will not be allowed for sale. No iron halters allowed. Please bring a white coat for showing. **Straw is provided by Carrick-on-Shannon Mart.**

NOTE: As a pre-requisite to entry for all ILCS sales, herds consigning cattle must be actively participating in a CHECS accredited

Johnes herd testing programme. This means all animals in the herd that are 24 months and over, whether pedigree Limousin or otherwise, are to be tested annually in accordance with the rules of CHECS.

Notice to Purchasers

Conditions of Sale

These Conditions of Sale apply to all pedigree registered Irish Limousin cattle exposed for sale, by or under the auspices of the Irish Limousin Cattle Society, by public auction or private treaty, and form the basis of the contract between the vendor and the purchaser, and from the contract all conditions and warranties implied under the Sale of Goods Act 1893 and the Sale of Goods and Supply of Services Act 1980 or any other statutory enactment or implied by any law or custom or usage are expressly excluded.

Title

All animals exposed for sale must be the bona fide property of the Vendor/s at the time of sale and free of all liens, charges and encumbrances.

Pedigree

The pedigree of each animal is guaranteed to be correct by the Vendor. The Vendor is responsible for the accuracy of all information concerning the pedigree description and health of an animal.

Should any dispute arise as to the pedigree of any animal exposed for sale, such dispute shall be referred to the Council of the Society or to such sub-Committee as the Council may appoint as Arbiters or Arbitrators and their decision shall be final.

Veterinary

The Society reserves the absolute right to take blood samples, hair samples and/or tissue samples from any animal presented at shows and sales and to have the sample/s independently analysed at a certified Laboratory. A sample will also be given to the Vendor for his/her own use if requested.

The Society may, prior to any Sale appoint an Inspector/s to inspect animals brought forward at the Sale in order to ascertain that such animals are fit for inclusion in the Sale. The Inspector/s so appointed shall be the sole judge/s as to whether or not an animal may be included in the Sale and shall have the power to debar from the Sale any animal which they consider is not of a fit standard. No Vendor will have any claim for damages in respect of any animal, which is rejected pursuant to this rule.

Animals affected with any disease of an infectious nature are prohibited from being brought to any sale held under the auspices of the Society, and should any such animal be knowingly or negligently brought, the Vendor will be held responsible for all damage or loss occasioned thereby. Affected animals which have been treated may be accepted provided they are accompanied by a Vet's certificate, certifying that treatment has been given and the condition is no longer contagious.

Sale

All animals are sold as they stand and the purchaser is deemed to have examined each animal and fully satisfied himself about the animal prior to sale.

No liability whatsoever is undertaken by the Society or the Auctioneers for the accuracy or otherwise of the statements appearing in a catalogue or made at / during a sale. The vendor is responsible for such statements and for any error, omission or miss-statement.

All sales will be in Euro. At auction a % commission of the purchase price is payable by the Purchaser. The commission is payable by the Purchaser on all animals purchased including those purchased privately after being exposed for Auction on the day of Sale and within the sale premises. The vendor or (failing him) the purchaser shall notify a private sale to the Auctioneers and the Society immediately and the purchase money shall be payable to them in full.

Immediately after the sale of an animal, the purchaser of that animal shall:

- (i) Sign the form of Purchase Confirmation supplied by the Irish Limousin Society or Auctioneer/Mart
- (ii) Give his name, address and proof of identity to the Irish Limousin Society if so required,
- (iii) Pay the full price (including the commission), and VAT if applicable, to the Auctioneer/ Mart/ Society.
- (iv) On the full price (including the commission) being paid, the Purchaser shall receive from the Auctioneer / Mart / Society a written removal order and shall at his/her own expense

remove the animal on the day of the sale or within such a period as may be laid down by the Auctioneers at the commencement of the Sale. No animal shall be removed without a written removal order and the animal so removed shall be recovered summarily without further warrant.

The right of property of each animal shall not pass to the purchaser until the full purchase price is paid and the conditions outlined above are met by the purchaser.

Warranty

Save as hereinafter provided, no warranty whatever is given as to the performance or fertility of any bull.

Bull Fertility Guarantee

The vendor shall and hereby does provide the following guarantee as to the fertility of each bull sold, through the ring at this sale.

GUARANTEE

The Vendor guarantees that each bull is capable of getting stock (females), by natural service, from fourteen months of age which shall be deemed to be fulfilled as soon as five females or fifty per cent, whichever is the lesser number of animals put to the bull are in calf to the bull by natural service subsequent to the Sale.

While all bulls are sold as potential breeding stock, due to their age at the time of Sale, their fertility cannot be proven. The guarantee and indemnity provided is for the purchase price of the bull only (as submitted by the society). Any cost associated with the validation of a claim and/or any other loss, damage or expenses incurred, whether direct or indirect, are excluded.

The Insurers for the purposes of this guarantee is FBD Insurance plc. Registered office FBD House, Bluebell, Dublin 12. Telephone 01 409 3200. FBD Insurance plc is regulated by the Central Bank of Ireland.

CONDITIONS

1. That incapacity or infertility as a result of injury from whatever cause, or by illness or disease suffered or contracted after the date of sale is not covered by the Guarantee.
 2. Should an animal be re-sold during the period of the guarantee the new Purchaser will not be entitled to the benefit of the guarantee.
 3. Under no circumstances will the insurers be liable for more than the purchase price of the animal.
 4. Every bull presented for sale has had a fertility test completed by a veterinary surgeon within 60 days of the sale date.
 5. FBD Policy applies to the Republic Of Ireland only. North Ireland and mainland UK are excluded from policy cover.
- (b) If, upon purchase of the bull, it is found impracticable for the Purchaser to fairly try the bull within the period stated at (a), due to the Purchaser's normal calving programme, the Insurers must be informed in writing immediately after the Sale. At the discretion of the Insurers the date of commencement of the three month guarantee trial period may be deferred for a further month beyond the date of purchase provided in which the Purchaser has notified them as aforesaid that he proposes to commence using the bull. The Insurers shall not unreasonably refuse to extend the time and in any event shall communicate its decision in writing to the Purchaser within seven days of receipt of the said notice from the Purchaser
- (c) The Purchaser shall give notice to the Insurers of an inability of the bull to put a female in a state of pregnancy by natural service, or a suspected inability in this respect not before the expiration of one month nor after the expiration of three months from the date of sale or of the bull attaining fourteen months, or any extension of the commencement of the trial period granted pursuant to (b) above, whichever is the later.

The foregoing guarantee is subject to the following conditions: –

- (a) The bull shall be fairly tried with a view to him putting a female in a state of pregnancy by natural service within three months of the date of sale, or within three months of attaining the age of fourteen months, whichever is the later. For the purposes of this guarantee a bull shall not be deemed to be "fairly tried" when less than three female animals in heat have been properly presented to or run with the bull.
- (d) On receipt of the notice referred to in (c) and in order to validate the fertility of the bull, the Insurers may request at their discretion that any of the following must be submitted to the Insurers, at the purchasers own expense, within 30 days of the date of notification:
- (i) A Bull fertility test and associated report;

- (ii) A certificate and report by a qualified veterinary surgeon declaring that the inability to put a female in a state of pregnancy by natural service is not the result of injury, accident, disease or neglect happening after the sale, and that he has examined the females on which the bull has been tried and has found them in a normal breeding condition and that they are not responsible for the bull's inability to put a female in a state of pregnancy by natural service;
- iii) A Scanning report
- (e) The Purchaser shall (if required) allow a Veterinary Surgeon appointed by the Insurers to examine and try the bull.
- (f) The insurer assumes salvage of any bull subject to a claim or deducts the salvage value from any claim settlement.
- (g) In the event of the Insurers and the Purchaser failing to agree on whether or not the bull is capable of fulfilling the guarantee in accordance with the forgoing provisions, or in the event of any other dispute arising between the parties concerning the implementation or interpretation of this guarantee, the said dispute shall be referred to the decision of a single arbitrator, to be appointed by agreement of the Insurers and the Purchaser, (Or in default of agreement to be nominated by the President for the time being of the Incorporated Law Society of Ireland). The aforementioned referral to arbitration shall be a condition precedent to the commencement of any other legal action. Claims not referred to arbitration from the date of disclaimer of liability shall be deemed to be abandoned.
- (h) All claims will be between the Purchaser and the Insurer subject to the terms and conditions of the guarantee.
- (i) All veterinary regulations under the Guarantee must be strictly adhered to and the rules of good pedigree animal husbandry must apply at all times.
- (j) The Society, the Auctioneer or the Mart Management/Owners will not be under any liability whatever to the Purchaser in respect of any loss sustained by the Purchaser howsoever arising, whether it be consequential or otherwise.

Female Fertility Guarantee

Any cow or heifer realising 500 gns, or more that is stated by vendor as having been served or artificially inseminated not less than 12 weeks before the date of the sale shall be guaranteed in calf to the service date or date of artificial insemination and to the bull stated, unless any alteration to the service particulars is announced from the rostrum or by the vendor at the time the animal is sold. The term "running with the Bull" implies no guarantee of pregnancy unless specifically stated by the vendor at the time of sale, neither shall the provision by the vendor of a certificate of positive pregnancy diagnosis imply any such guarantee this being merely an expression of opinion.

Every heifer sold as unserved shall be so guaranteed and all such heifers (unless sold suckling their dams) shall carry a guarantee that they are capable of breeding. Calves sold suckling their dams are given to the purchaser free and no guarantees apply unless specifically stated by the vendor at the time of sale.

No claim under these Rules will be effective

unless made to the Auctioneers or to the vendor within the following time limits, as applicable, viz:

- (a) In the case of a cow or heifer sold as being in calf which proved NOT to be in calf, within 49 days of the date of sale.
- (b) In the case of a cow or heifer which, although in calf, does not calve to the stated service or insemination date, within TWO CALENDAR MONTHS of the date that the animal should have calved according to the particulars of service or insemination stated in the catalogue of sale, in all such cases, no claim will be admissible unless there is an interval of more than four weeks between the presumed due date (according to the stated particulars of service or insemination) and the actual calving date.
- (c) Where a cow or heifer calves at a later date than the due date the onus of proving the identity of the service bull shall be upon the vendor.
- (d) Where a heifer is sold as unserved and which subsequently proves to have been in calf at the time, within SIX CALENDAR MONTHS of the date of sale.
- (e) In the case of a maiden heifer which proves incapable of breeding because of malformation or abnormality of the genital system, not before the animal attains the age of TWENTY SEVEN MONTHS and no claim under this rule be admissible after the animal has attained the age of THIRTY SIX MONTHS.

NOTE: Any female (cow or heifer) that has been flushed for embryo transplant will be

EXCLUDED from the terms of this guarantee but individual vendors of such animals shall have the option of giving their personal guarantee to be announced at the time of sale. No claims will be admitted under these rules where it can be proved that a cow or heifer is carrying a mummified calf, or has aborted or re-absorbed a foetus and no guarantee is given or implied that any cow or heifer will carry a calf full term. All claims must be submitted to the vendor and the Secretary of the Society and shall be resolved in accordance with the provisions of clauses (f) and (g) below.

- (f) In the event of the vendor and the purchaser failing to agree on whether or not the heifer is incapable of breeding in accordance with the foregoing provisions, or in the event of any other dispute arising between the parties concerning the implementation or interpretation of this agreement, the said dispute shall be and is hereby referred to arbitration by a single arbitrator, to be agreed between the vendor and the purchaser (or in default of agreement to be nominated by the President for the time being of the Incorporated Law Society of Ireland), such arbitration to be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration Acts 1954 and 1980. The aforementioned referral to arbitration shall be a condition precedent to the commencement of any other legal action.

In the event of the vendor and purchaser (or in default the Arbitrator) concluding that a heifer is incapable of breeding in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Agreement, then the Vendor shall

- (1) Be bound to accept the return of

the heifer and on delivery of it to his premises (Unless some other arrangements shall be mutually agreed upon) to refund to the purchaser the whole of the purchase price of the heifer together with the expenses of the purchaser's veterinary surgeons, the cost of carriage from the purchaser's premises to the Vendor's premises, the carriage and keep of the heifer from the date of notification of the claim, provided however that such expenses and costs shall not exceed an amount equal to ten percent of the sale price of the heifer.

- (2) Pay the costs of the arbitration and the arbitrator in accordance with any direction given by the arbitrator in this regard. Save as aforesaid the vendor shall not be under any liability whatever to the purchaser in respect of loss sustained by the purchaser however this loss arises and whether it be consequential or otherwise.
- (g) Where it is determined by agreement, arbitration or otherwise that a heifer is incapable of breeding, the vendor must re-take possession of the heifer and refund the purchaser the sale price of the heifer together with agreed expenses up to an amount not to exceed ten percent of the sale price of the heifer. The vendor shall not be under any liability whatsoever to the purchaser in respect of any other loss sustained by the purchaser however this loss arises and whether it be consequential or otherwise.

General

In the event of Sale by Auction and there arising conflict between these condition and

the General Conditions of the Auction, these conditions shall prevail.

Neither the Society, the Auctioneers or the Marts shall be responsible for any injury, damage, or loss sustained by any person or animal on the premises of the Auctioneers or the Mart whether as a result of the negligence of the Auctioneers, the Marts or the Society or of their respective servants, or Agents or otherwise, nor for any damages by animals prior to, during or after the sale. Any dispute as to any matter for which no provision is made in these Rules shall be referred to an Arbiter or Arbiters to be appointed, failing agreement between or amongst the parties, by the Auctioneers or by the Society. The decision of the Arbiters so appointed shall be final and binding on all parties to the dispute. Any Arbitration under this Clause shall be subject to the provision of the Arbitration Act for the time being in force in the Republic of Ireland and shall be deemed to be a reference to Arbitration there under.

The Auctioneers act as Agents for the Vendors and any action taken by a Purchaser must be against the Vendor and not against the Auctioneers, the Mart or the Society. No responsibility whatever rests with the Society, the Mart or the auctioneers in regard to the qualifications of the animals sold by Auction or being sold privately and all purchases must be made on this distinct understanding.

These Conditions of Sale shall be interpreted in accordance with the law of the Republic of Ireland.

Notice to Purchasers

Conditions of Sale at Auction of Pedigree Cattle

Every Seller, Bidder, Purchaser and the General Public on the Auctioneers premises shall be deemed to have full knowledge of these Conditions and agree to be bound by them. In the event of a Sale by Auction and there arising conflict between these conditions and the General Conditions of the Sale of the Irish Limousin Cattle Society, the General Conditions will prevail.

The highest bidder shall be declared the Purchaser. In the event of any dispute the Auctioneer shall have absolute discretion either to settle the dispute or re-offer the animal immediately.

No person shall advance at any bidding less than a sum to be named by the auctioneer and no bidding shall be retracted

No seller or seller's representative shall bid for sellers own livestock

The Auctioneers and/or the Society reserve the right to refuse any bid without giving a reason for doing so.

The Auctioneers and/or Society may withdraw any animal for which the bidding is considered insufficient.

The Auctioneers / Society reserve the right to fix a reserve price, or to rearrange, consolidate or withdraw any lots to vary the order of sale.

Each animal forward at the Sale must be offered for sale by auction before any private sale shall be permitted or recognised by the

Auctioneers and/or the Society. The usual commission will be charged in respect of every animal offered for auction and not sold in the ring and subsequently sold by the owner or his agent. The vendor or (failing him) the purchaser shall notify a private sale to the Auctioneers and the Society immediately and the purchase money shall be payable to them in full.

Each lot shall be at the Sellers risk from the time it enters the Mart / Auctioneers premises, until sold.

Each animal shall be at the purchaser's absolute risk from the fall of the hammer, and shall be removed from the sales premises at the purchaser's expense.
