Risk of harm to a child by an adult or another child, including definitions of abuse	<p>Dealing with and reporting allegations or concerns of abuse.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deputy Liaison Person (DLP) and Deputy Designated Liaison Person (DDL) have been named and ratified by Council as part of the Child Safeguarding Statement [23/05/2023] • The DLP and the DDL are responsible at an initial stage for dealing with any concerns relating to possible abuse of children as reported and made known to them. This is in accordance with the Children First Response Pathways (Appendix 2, page 23 and 24 - TUSLA A Guide for Reporting of Child Protection and Welfare Concerns) • The ILCS are committed to taking appropriate action where allegations or suspicions of abuse are made known to us and to sharing such information to the relevant statutory authorities in accordance with legislation and relevant guidelines
Risk of harm when hosting an activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All relevant YMA persons are Garda Vetted and have been trained on their responsibilities as a Mandated Person in accordance with the Children First Act (2015)
Risk of harm through online abuse and social media Inappropriate use of photography	Refer to Acceptable Use Policy regarding guidelines around Social Media/Photos/Videos.
